

## LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

SNA and SNAPA closely monitor all school nutrition related bills and legislation. Information on this legislation SNA's [Action Network](#). Three (3) new Federal bills that impact school nutrition programs were introduced in July 2021:

- Senator Kirsten Gillibrand (D-NY) along with Senators Bernie Sanders (I-VT), Cory Booker (D-NJ), Alex Padilla (D-CA), Elizabeth Warren (D-MA) and Congresswoman Alma Adams (D-NC) introduced [S. 2192](#) or [H.R. 4077](#), the Closing the Meal Gap Act of 2021.
- Representatives Mark DeSaulnier (D-CA) and Glenn Thompson (R-PA) introduced [H.R. 4379](#), the School Food Modernization Act.
- Representative Frederica Wilson (D-FL) introduced [H.R. 4344](#), the Salad Bars in Schools Expansion Act.
